Digital Pedagogy: A way for transformative Education

Teaching and learning activities have to be dynamic activities which must be changed and updated as per necessity of learners and other circumstances. Since digitalization is one of the most impressive change of the current world, its integration in learning activities was an essential milestone in our institution. We were forced to use online platform for teaching and learning at the time of COVID pandemic. At that time we, SCTI used online teaching like zoom meeting and social media platform for the teaching and learning. After normalization from the COVID, we again softly moved to the face to face sessions as the curriculum is specially designed for as at least 80% physical presence is mandatory for the fulfillment final evaluation criteria.

After the NEWSTEP project, we have known digital and innovative pedagogical system which smoothly helped us to move towards hybrid or blended pedagogy which involves both physical and online pedagogical activities to ensure the benefits of both the approaches. We took a couple of online guiding classes by the Work package 2 (WP2) team and planned to conduct piloting digital and online pedagogical with continuous support from the WP2 team.

We used "Ublcloud" as learning management system for the piloting. Its main features are content building, learning resources collection, assignments of file uploads and written type, quiz, grading, online discussion forum and attendance. We are piloting 6 courses for two faculties Diploma in Civil Engineering and Veterinary Science. We are taking partial involvement of online platform in the classes for example for quiz works, assignment submission, teaching material distributions etc.

Learn, Earn and Pay

To promote learning by doing, hands-on learning and entrepreneurship in TVET, SCTI has introduced the “learn, earn, and pay” concept through initiatives such as poultry, pig farming, and cow farming. Looking ahead, we plan to expand this concept to include goat farming, beekeeping, and construction-related fields. The objectives of the concept are:

- 1.To increase the technical training in the relevant field,
- 2.To develop SCTI human resource management,
- 3.To enhance the institution as a self-sustained technical institute,
- 4.To uplift the economic status of the students,
- 5.To promote entrepreneurial skills of the students
